Granite: Granite is a natural stone. It is quarried from the mountains of Italy, the U.S., India, Brazil and many other countries around the world. Granite is available in an array of different colors, granite's durability and longevity make it ideal for kitchen countertops and other heavily used surfaces, including table tops and floors. It resists heat and bacteria and is hard to scratch and with proper cleaning will not stain under normal use. Because of its exceptional strength it is well suited for exterior applications such as paving, and curbing as well. This product does need to be sealed because it is a porous natural stone.

Solid Surface: A resin that brings design versatility, long-term performance and value to any environment. It lends itself to imaginative uses. It can be cut, routed, drilled, sculpted, bent, or worked like a fine wood. There are color choices of the rainbow. Some are solid, while others create a more textured effect. It does tend to scratch more than natural stone but can be easily buffed out.

Laminate: High pressure decorative laminate is saturating sheets of decorative and core paper with resins, pressing them under high heat fusing layers into a single sheet. 18% resin and the rest is paper. Sheets are bonded using special adhesives to substrates made of plywood, fiberboard or particle board which gives resistance from wear and impact. Durability, easy maintenance, resistance to salt and low price make this product very popular.
